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

Case No. 15-0515 *RED*

The Board of Appeals held a public hearing on Thursday, December 17, 2015 in the Selectmen's Meeting Room at Town Hall, 16 Lowell Street in Reading, Massachusetts to hear the petition of the Reading Cooperative Bank (the "Petitioner"). The Petitioner sought a Variance under Section 8.0/8.2.3/8.2.6.4a of the Reading Zoning Bylaw in order to install two additional wall signs and allow the existing sign to remain on the property located at 180 Haven Street in Reading, Massachusetts.

The Petitioner presented the plan for the additional signage including response to the criteria for variance. After a discussion of the proposed plan among Board members and opening the meeting for public comment, the Petitioner requested to withdraw their application without prejudice, which request was approved unanimously by the Board.
