To Whom it May Concern:

**After My Most Recent Site Visit Since The Tree Removals and Lot Clearing on
June 26th, 27th and July 3rd, 2024**

My Findings are as follows:

**There has been some excavation and construction damage to 6 to 7 assorted
Specie Trees From either equipment contact and/or spoil pile placement.
Some minor and some moderate bark Sloughing (exfoliating or tearing) which is
often the case where major excavating, Digging and lot preparation takes place.**

**All the Identified trees in Question have Not suffered nor has the structural
integrity been compromised to the point where removals should take place to
insure the safety and stability of any of the scared trees.**

**In my professional opinion the best treatment would be to apply a topical wound
ointment called Lac Balsam which is best known to be a tree wound sealant. It
provides protection against insect and disease organisms that are attracted to
open wounds. It also aesthetically dresses up the damaged area and speeds up
the healing process.**

***Additional Information: Application of this product should be done
within the first six months of the inception of the damage.***
